Success measures

Learning and teaching

Goal

 Whole school curriculum delivery plan finalised to improve student learning outcomes.

Strategies

- Finalise the SOARing at OLHC document to ensure consistent teaching and learning expectations across year levels.
- Build on Short Term Planning cycles in English and Mathematics and begin to implement Short Term Planning cycles across other learning areas.
- Focus on developing Assessment capable learners who have the resilience, confidence and skills to demonstrate their knowledge, understanding and proficiencies across all learning areas and in assessment situations (NAPLAN).
- Liaise with external consultants to continue to build capacity around consistent practices for supporting learners, with a focus on identifying high potential learners.

Success measures

- SOARing at OLHC document completed and shared with wider school community.
- Evidence of Short Term Planning Cycles across all learning areas.
- Access student voice to assess mindsets regarding assessment capabilities and readiness.
- Access student voice to assess high potential learner student engagement.

Organisational Effectiveness

Goal

By the end of 2021 our Master Plan will complete stage one to enhance the street appeal of the school and cater for the continued growth in student enrolments.

Strategies

Continue to work with Parish, Staff and Parent committees to share the vision and strategic requirement for stage one.

Success measures

New carpark to increase safety. New library to create space for additional Year Two classroom in 2022.

<u>Goal</u>

 Review community partnerships to improve student enrolment predictions.

Strategies

- Streamline enrolment processes and align with local Catholic schools to generate earlier student enrolment predictions for 2022.
- Enhance connection to local early learning centres creating a greater presence in the community.

Success Measures
