# **UNIFORM DRESS CODE**

The wearing of our uniforms demonstrates pride in our school and is an advertisement for our school community. All students are expected to wear the correct school uniform at all times. Ribbons, bottle green, scrunchies and headbands must be green and white stripe as per school formal uniform. All uniforms should be neat and tidy. If the wearing of non-uniforms items is unavoidable, the child must bring a note for their teacher.

In winter both girls and boys are permitted to wear either the green school vest with emblem, or green school jumper with emblem with their formal uniform.

Please note: School vests and jumpers are NOT to be worn with sports uniforms.

# **UNISEX SPORTS UNIFORMS**

- Bottle green polo shirt with school emblem
- Bottle green long leg shorts
- Bottle green OLHC ankle socks
- · White sandshoes

In winter both girls and boys are permitted to wear the school Tracksuit with school emblem over their sports uniform. The Tracksuit may be worn as a complete outfit or jacket only.

Please note:- Tracksuits are NOT to be worn with the formal uniform.

## **SWIMMING**

Green and gold swimmers and sun safe top and green bathing cap.

#### AS A MATTER OF SAFETY STUDENTS SHOULD ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES:

The only jewellery permitted is small studs or sleepers gold or silver for girls with pierced ears.

- Girls with shoulder length hair or longer must have it tied back.
- All shirts must be worn tucked in.
- It is expected that boys will have neatly trimmed acceptable hair styles.
- It is not permissible for students to wear make-up other than moisturiser, sunscreen and lotions/cream for health reasons.
- Caps are not sufficiently sun safe to be worn to school at anytime.
- All items of clothing should be clearly named.
